Our fee structure is monthly as follows:

- British School (GCSE) **£50** per subject (R1000 per subject)
- British School (AS Levels) £75 per subject (R1500 per subject)
- · British School (A Levels) £100 per subject (R2000 per subject)
- · South African IEB (Grade 10, 11 & 12) R3990 per month (Fee based on Core 7 subjects)

• £200 per month (R3820 per month) (Fee based on 9 core learning areas)
